## General information

**Venue:** Ikast, Jutland, Denmark  
**Competition days:** October 19<sup>th</sup> – 21<sup>st</sup>  
**Official day of arrival:** October 18<sup>th</sup>  
**Official day of departure:** October 21<sup>st</sup> (late) or October 22<sup>nd</sup> (early)

**By bus/car:** Ikast is located in Jutland on road nr. 15 between Århus and Herning.

We are living in rooms where our student normally lives, therefore we kindly ask you to show all respect you can for their things in the rooms.

We kindly ask you to bring bed linen (sengelinned) and towels, we provide duvet (dyne) and pillow.

We can host you from Saturday the 16<sup>th</sup>. It will cost you 35 euro extra pr. person pr. day.

### **Meals**

All meals will be served at Idrætsskolerne Ikast.

Meal times will be determined according to the match and training schedule.

Please let us know if there are vegetarians or persons that are allergic to something.

We can serve you with meals between meals (snack; fruit and bread) – price: 5 euro pr. person pr. day. Please let us know in advance, if you like us to provide that for you.

### **Transportation**

Distance from Idrætsskolerne (accommodation) to Ikast-Brande Arena is 400 m. So we will walk forth and back.

### **Medical services**

Ice is available all time at accommodation so that you can bring it to matches and training.

The nearest hospital is located in Herning (15 minutes by car)

### **Registration**

Each participating team can register a delegation composed of maximum 12 players and 4 officials + 1 international referee/team.

The visiting teams are kindly requested to send the CEV CH-05 form to the organizers at the latest 30 days before the competition either by fax or by e-mail.

**NB!** The Danish Volleyball Association would like to have the exact arrival and departure times of the visiting teams as soon as possible.

### **Financial matters**

Each participating team will cover

- Travel all the way to Ikast and home again
- Payment of their own international referees

## **Rules**

FIVB rules are valid for the tournament. Except for the following issues:

### **Libero**

The libero can be changed to other player in between matches during the tournament.

Each team can use two liberos in each match.

The liberos follows the normal rules of substitutions. Meaning that they can be substituted forth and back every set with each other. Headcoach can between each set decide which libero starts in the next set. Libero substitutions do not affect other substitutions.

### **Playing Protocol**

Warm Up	1 hour before start
Toss	18 minutes to start
Warm up 2 x 5 min. At net + serve	17 minutes to start
Warm up stops – Line up – presenting the captains	5 minutes to start
National anthems	4 minutes to start
Handing over pins etc.	
Starting players sitting on the bench	
Presentation referees	2 minutes to start
Presentation starting 7 players + HC	1 minutes to start

If the match before is delayed, you will have, all together, 30 minutes before next match starts.  
There are warming up facilities in a minor gym.

### **Competition and Training schedule**

Training times will be confirmed after receiving the teams' arrival times. We will make sure that all teams have at least one hour of training on competition court before the matches starts.

Game plan will be confirmed after receiving the participating teams final registration.

5 teams – all against all – will be 4 matches pr. team

6 teams – 2 groups – will be 3-4 matches pr. team

7 teams – 2 groups – will be 4-5 matches pr. team
